With the fall of Communism, many Jews chose to leave the Former Soviet Union, but an estimated 500,000 or more remain. During the 65 years of Soviet rule, Judaism was virtually outlawed, and Jewish infrastructure collapsed.

The World Union operates a range of congregations and programs designed to engage and educate individuals and families in a creative, contemporary Judaism.
